WIDOWS', ORPHANS' AND OLD AGE CONTRIBUTORY PENSIONS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1936.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the National Health Insurance Joint Committee, the Minister of Health, the Department of Health for Scotland and the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, acting jointly or severally, after the expiration of at least forty days from this date, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 134 of the National Health Insurance Act, 1936, the Widows', Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Act, 1936, the Widows', Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Act (Northern Ireland), 1936, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, to make regulations to be entitled the National Health Insurance and Contributory Pensions (Officers of the Reserve) Regulations, 1938.
