

(3) Safety Lamps (Re-lighting) Order, 1938—amending the Safety Lamps (Re-lighting) Order, 1929, in the matter of the provision of an electric lamp to permit examination of a flame lamp which may have been extinguished underground in such manner as might render it unsafe, prior to re-lighting.

(4) Telephones and Signalling Apparatus Order, 1938—prescribing types of telephones, signalling apparatus and coupling-units approved for the purpose of No. 8 of the Coal Mines General Regulations, 1938, and laying down conditions of manufacture, installation and use.
