To correct Return for Period 15th-19th September, 1938:—

Silver Coin, of legal tender in the United Kingdom, from Other Countries, Add £700.
Silver Coin, not of legal tender in the United Kingdom, from Other Countries, Add £103.

To correct Return for Period 27th-31st October, 1938:—

Silver Coin, of legal tender in the United Kingdom, from British West Africa, Deduct £1,090.
Silver Coin, not of legal tender in the United Kingdom, from British West Africa, Deduct £43.

To correct Return for Period 21st-24th November, 1938:—

Gold Coin, not of legal tender in the United Kingdom, from Netherlands, Deduct £41.

To correct Return for Period 24th-28th November, 1938:—

Gold Bullion, Refined, accepted in inter-bank transactions, from France, Deduct £135.

Silver Coin, of legal tender in the United Kingdom, from Belgium, Deduct £200.

To correct Return for Period 28th November-1st December, 1938:—

Gold Coin, of legal tender in the United Kingdom, from Switzerland, Deduct £30.
