## RULES PUBLICATION ACT, 1893.

### IN THE MATTER OF THE LONDON TRAFFIC ACT, 1924.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that he proposes after the expiration of at least 40 days from this date in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by Section 10 of the London Traffic Act, 1924, to make Regulations revoking the London Traffic (Prescribed Routes) Consolidation Regulations, 1938 (S.R. & O., 1938, No. 455), in so far as they relate to one-way traffic working on the south-western side of the crescent-shaped island site at the junction of Uxbridge Road (A.40) with Coldharbour Lane (A.312) Hayes, Middlesex.

### LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930.
