FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) SPECIAL ORDER No. 13 OF 1939.

SUBJECT.

I. Contracts the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Areas around Leckford, Hampshire, as from the 21st January, 1939, so as to comprise only the Area described in the Schedule.

II. Releases the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area around Leckford, Hampshire, and revokes Order No. 5797, as from the 28th January, 1939.
