

north-north-east of Saline in the County of Fife. Thence in a general east-north-easterly direction along the road past Bogside in the County of Kinross to Cleish, and thence in a general east-south-easterly direction past Sunnyside and Binn, and in a north-easterly direction past Ballingry in the County of Fife, West Mains in the County of Kinross, Balbedie in the County of Fife, and Auchmuirbridge, and through the town of Leslie by way of the main road to the road junction by Eglantine Square.

*Eastern Boundary.*

Thence along the road in a south-south-easterly direction past Woodside, Thornton and Gallatown to the road junction about 600 feet south-west of Dysart Railway Station. Thence in a north-easterly direction for about 100 feet to the road junction, thence in a south-easterly direction to a point on the coast at high water mark about 200 feet north of Lady Blanche Coal Pit at Dysart.

*Southern Boundary.*

Thence in a general south-westerly direction along the coast at high water mark past Kirkcaldy, Burntisland and Inverkeithing Bay to the Forth Bridge. Thence along the main road in a north-westerly direction to the road junction about 900 feet west of Jamestown and in a general west-south-westerly direction along the coast road past Brucehaven and through Limekilns to the railway terminus at Charles-town. Thence along the railway in a westerly and north-westerly direction to the point where it crosses a stream about 1,300 feet north-west of Braeside. Thence along the coast at high water mark in a westerly and north-westerly direction to the point where the railway runs along the coast west of Torryburn. Thence along the railway in a westerly direction to the road from New Mills.

*Western Boundary.*

Thence in a northerly direction along the road past New Mills to Over Inzievar and in an easterly direction to the road junction south of Oakley Railway Station. Thence in a northerly direction past Oakley and in a westerly direction to Comrie. Thence in a general northerly direction through Saline, past Balgonar and Hill End to the road junction  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile south-west of Meadowhead, the point of departure.
