NOTICE is hereby given that an application has been made to the Electricity Commissioners by the Ipswich County Borough Council for the consent of the Commissioners under Section 11 of the Electricity (Supply) Act, 1919, to establish a generating station for the purposes of the Ipswich Corporation Electric Lighting Order, 1897, the Ipswich and Felixstowe (Bulk Supply) Special Order, 1926, and the Ipswich Electricity (Extension) Special Order, 1930, on a site on the East bank of the River Orwell at Ipswich, adjacent to the Cliff Quay and the Sewerage Outfall Works, comprising parcels of land Ordnance Nos. 84, 91, 93 (part), 100, 100A, 101 (part), 102 (part), 103 and 104 (part) (1927 edition) and a portion of the foreshore adjoining.

A plan showing the land in question, together with a plan and an elevation drawing of the generating station and a description of the machinery proposed to be installed therein, has been deposited for public inspection at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, Ipswich.

If any Owner or Lessee of property situate within three hundred yards of the proposed site wish to state objections to the application, they must do so by registered letter addressed to the Secretary, Electricity Commission, Savoy Court, Strand, London, W.C.2, within fourteen days from the date hereof, and a copy of the objection must be addressed to me.
