NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACT, 1936.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Pub-
lication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the
National Health Insurance Joint Committee,
after the expiration of at least forty days from
this date, in exercise of the powers conferred
by the National Health Insurance Act, 1936,
and of all other powers enabling them in that
behalf, to make regulations to be entitled the
National Health Insurance (Arrears) Amend-
ment Regulations 1939;

And that on account of urgency the National
Health Insurance Joint Committee under
Section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893,
made regulations entitled the National Health
Insurance (Arrears) Amendment Regulations
1939, to come into operation forthwith as pro-
visional rules, to continue in force until regula-
tions have been made in accordance with the
provisions of Section 1 of that Act.

COLNE VALLEY SEWERAGE BOARD.

Public Health (Drainage of Trade Premises) Act, 1937.
