ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1934 (SECTION 1).

SPEED LIMITS IN THE LONDON TRAFFIC AREA.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Transport under and by virtue of the provisions of sub-section (4) of Section 1 of the Road Traffic Act, 1934, intends to make the London Traffic (Built up Areas) (No.) Order, 1939, the effect of which will be that the speed limit under the said Section will apply in the London - Carlisle - Glasgow - Inverness Trunk Road (Hendon Way and Watford Way (A.500)), at Hendon, Middlesex, between Park Road and The Burroughs (A.502).

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1934 (SECTION 1).

SPEED LIMITS IN THE LONDON TRAFFIC AREA.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Transport under and by virtue of the provisions of paragraph (b) of sub-section (4) of Section 1 of the Road Traffic Act, 1934, intends to make the London Traffic (Built up Areas) (No.) Order, 1939, the effect of which will be that the speed limit under the said Section will apply throughout every length of road specified in the Schedule hereto.

THE SCHEDULE.

HERTFORDSHIRE.

Battlers Green.

(i) New Road, from the Radlett-Letchmore Heath-Elstree Road north-westwards for a distance of 293 yards.

(ii) Radlett-Letchmore Heath-Elstree Road between points 242 yards north-east and 28 yards south-east of New Road.

Datchworth and Datchworth Green.

Datchworth-Bulls Green Road from the northern boundary wall of Datchworth Church to a point 10 yards south of the Watton-Knebworth Road, Datchworth Green.

Letchmore Heath.

(i) Letchmore Heath-Roundbush Road;

(a) northern arm, from the Radlett-Letchmore Heath-Elstree Road, for a distance of 160 yards westwards; and

(b) southern arm, from the aforesaid Radlett-Letchmore Heath-Elstree Road, for a distance of 225 yards north-westwards.

(ii) Radlett-Letchmore Heath-Elstree Road, between a point 40 yards north-east of the northern arm of the Letchmore Heath-Roundbush Road and a point 85 yards south-east of the southern arm of the aforesaid Letchmore Heath-Roundbush Road.

Stapleford.

Hertfordshire-Watton Road (A.602), from the approach to the railway station north-westwards for a distance of 700 yards.

Tonwell.

Ware-Watton Road (B.1001), from the footpath leading to Dimmings Wood south-eastwards for a distance of 367 yards.
