
Southwark, and has been consecrated and is known as the Church of Saint Paul, Battersea:

And whereas the Right Reverend Richard Godfrey, Bishop of Southwark, as Diocesan, the Reverend the Honourable Orlando St. Maur Weld Forester, Clerk in Holy Orders, as Vicar or Incumbent of the Vicarage of the Parish of Battersea, in the said county and diocese, and, as such Vicar or Incumbent, Patron of the Vicarage of the said New Parish of Saint John, Battersea, and the Reverend Douglas Frederick Kennedy Kennedy-Bell, Clerk in Holy Orders, as Vicar or Incumbent of the said Vicarage of the New Parish of Saint John, Battersea, have by an Instrument under their hands, bearing date the sixth day of February in the year one thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine, certified to us, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, that it would be for the convenience of the said New Parish of Saint John, Battersea, that the said new Church of Saint Paul, Battersea, situate within such New Parish, should be substituted for the old parish church (known as the Church of Saint John, Battersea) of the same New Parish:

Now, therefore, we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in exercise and execution of the power or authority in that behalf contained in the Act of the eighth and ninth years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter seventy, and in the Act of the nineteenth and twentieth years of Her said late Majesty, chapter fifty-five, and of all other powers or authorities in anywise enabling us in the same behalf, do by this Instrument under our Common Seal, with the consent (testified as hereinafter mentioned) of the said Richard Godfrey, Bishop of Southwark, and of the said Orlando St. Maur Weld Forester and of the said Douglas Frederick Kennedy Kennedy-Bell hereby declare that the said new Church of Saint Paul, Battersea, situate within the said New Parish of Saint John, Battersea, and duly consecrated as aforesaid, shall be and the same is hereby substituted for the said old parish

church of the same New Parish, and that such new church shall henceforth be the parish church of the said New Parish of Saint John, Battersea, in lieu of the said old parish church of the same New Parish as fully in all respects as if the said new Church of Saint Paul, Battersea, so hereby substituted, had been originally the parish church of the same New Parish; and we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in further pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities aforesaid, and with such consents as aforesaid (testified as hereinafter mentioned), do hereby transfer all the endowments, emoluments, and rights of or belonging to the said old parish church of the said New Parish of Saint John, Battersea, or of or belonging to the Vicar or Incumbent thereof, to the said new Church of Saint Paul, Battersea (now being by virtue of these presents the parish church of the said New Parish of Saint John, Battersea) and to the Vicar or Incumbent thereof and his successors for ever.

In witness whereof to these presents we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, have set our Common Seal, and the said Richard Godfrey, Bishop of Southwark, has set his hand and affixed his Episcopal Seal, and the said Orlando St. Maur Weld Forester and the said Douglas Frederick Kennedy Kennedy-Bell have respectively set their hands and affixed their seals, this twenty-seventh day of April in the year one thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine.
