BACON INDUSTRY ACTS, 1938 AND 1939.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries and the Secretary of State for Scotland, acting in conjunction, and with the approval of the Treasury have made the following Regulations in pursuance of Section 28 of the Bacon Industry Act, 1938, as amended by the Bacon Industry (Amendment) Act, 1939:—

(1) "The Bacon Industry (Proof of Production) Regulations, 1939," in accordance with which a curer may prove, for the purposes of the said Section 28, that a quantity of bacon has been produced from certain pigs. These Regulations also prescribe the prescribed fraction of the dead weight of a pig for the purposes of the said section.

(2) "The Bacon Industry (Ascertained Lard Price) Regulations, 1939," specifying the description of lard and the markets at which prices are to be taken, for the purposes of the said Section 28.
