RADNORSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1930.

ROAD AND RAIL TRAFFIC ACT, 1933.

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 19th July, 1939, the Minister of Transport confirmed the Radnorshire County Council (Roads Restriction) Order, 1939, made by the Radnorshire County Council under Section 46 (1) of the Road Traffic Act, 1930, and Section 29 of the Road and Rail Traffic Act, 1933.

The Order provides that, subject to certain exceptions,

no person shall drive any heavy locomotive, light locomotive, motor tractor or heavy motor car on the following lengths of road in the parish of Llansaintffraid-Cwm-dauddwr:—

1. The road over Craig-yr-allt-goch Dam in the Elan Valley, a distance of 218 yards.
2. The road on the west side of Craig-yr-allt-goch Reservoir from a point 300 yards west of the existing gateway at Craig-yr-allt-goch Dam to the junction with the old road leading from Aberystwyth to Rhayader, a distance of about 2.91 miles.
3. The road on the west side of Caban-coch Reservoir from the bridge over the river Claerwen to the junction with the Elan Valley road leading from Rhayader to Craig-yr-allt-goch Dam, a distance of about 2.21 miles.

THE ADMINISTRATIVE COUNTY OF WEST SUSSEX.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1930.

ROAD AND RAIL TRAFFIC ACT, 1933.

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 26th July, 1939, the Minister of Transport confirmed the Administrative County of West Sussex (Roads Restriction) (No. 1) Order, 1939, made by the County Council of the Administrative County of West Sussex under Section 46 (1) of the Road Traffic Act, 1930, and Section 29 of the Road and Rail Traffic Act, 1933. The Order provides that subject to certain exceptions no person shall drive any vehicle on either length of road specified in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE.

Those lengths of the Horsham-Crawley Road (A.264) in the Parish of Crawley which lie:—

- (a) between its junction with the north-eastern side of the Crawley By-Pass Road and a point 20 yards north thereof; and
- (b) between its junction with the south-western side of the Crawley By-Pass Road and a point 20 yards south-west thereof.
