SUSPENSION OF OUTSTANDING EXPORT LICENCES FOR WAR MATERIAL FOR FOREIGN COUNTRIES.

Whereas by the Arms Export Prohibition Order, 1931, the export of certain goods is prohibited except under a licence of the Board of Trade;

And whereas it is desirable in the interests of Imperial security that all licences (with certain exceptions) hitherto granted by the Board of Trade for the export of goods should be reviewed and for that purpose their validity forthwith suspended;

Now, therefore, the Board of Trade in the exercise of all powers enabling them in that behalf do hereby direct and declare as follows:—

- I. Subject to the exceptions enumerated in the next following paragraph hereof all licences granted by the Board in connection with the said Order before the date hereof for the export of any goods shall be suspended and of no effect during the period commencing on the date hereof and ending on the 1st October, 1939.
- 2. Nothing in the preceding paragraph hereof shall be taken as suspending or affecting the operation of any of the following licences, that is to say:
  - (i) any licence authorising the export of any goods to any destination in any part of His Majesty's dominions, in any British protectorate or British protected state, or in any territory in respect of which a mandate on behalf of the League of Nations has been accepted by His Majesty and is being exercised by the Government of any part of His Majesty's dominions;
  - (ii) the open General Export Licences Nos. G.L. 168 (dated 14th July, 1937), G.L. 169 (dated 8th June, 1937) and G.L. 170 (dated 8th June, 1937);
  - (iii) any other licence if and in so far as it authorises only the export of aircraft (not being aircraft included in the Air Ministry list of military types);
  - (iv) any other licence if and in so far as it authorises only the export of (a) shotguns or components of shotguns, (b) shot cartridges, or (c) smokeless gunpowder or explosives of any of the descriptions enumerated in the aforesaid Open General Export Licence No. G.L. 169; or
  - (v) any other licence if and in so far as it authorises only the export of (a) not more than 25 rifles, revolvers or pistols and/or
