that the Officers of the Retired and Emergency Lists of the Royal Navy and Royal Marines, and the Special Reserve of Engineer Officers of the Royal Navy shall be called out for actual service in a time of war or emergency by Royal Proclamation directing the said Officers to hold themselves in readiness for actual service, and authorising the Admiralty to employ all or any of the Officers so called out as they may think fit:

And whereas a case of emergency has arisen : We do hereby order and direct that Officers of the Retired and Emergency Lists of the Royal Navy and Royal Marines, and the

Special Reserve of Engineer Officers of the Royal Navy, do hold themselves in readiness for actual service, and do hereby authorise the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty to employ all or any of the said Officers as they may think fit.

Given at Our Court at Buckingham Palace, this twenty-first day of September, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine, and in the Third year of Our Reign.
