INSTRUMENT substituting the Church of Saint Michael and All Angels situate within the Parish of Little Ilford, in the County of Essex and in the Diocese of Chelmsford for the old Church of Saint Mary the Virgin, situate within and hitherto being the parish church of the same parish.

To all to whom these presents shall come, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England send greeting:

Whereas a Church has been built within the Parish of Little Ilford in the County of Essex and in the Diocese of Chelmsford and has been consecrated and is known as the Church of Saint Michael and All Angels, Little Ilford:

And whereas the Right Reverend Henry, Bishop of Chelmsford, as Diocesan, Cecil Herbert Stuart Fifoot, a Fellow of Hertford College in the University of Oxford, acting on behalf of the Hertford College Advowson Trustees, as the Patrons of the Rectory of the said Parish of Little Ilford, and the Reverend Hubert Arthur Stanley Pink, Clerk in Holy Orders, as the Rector or Incumbent of the said Rectory of the Parish of Little Ilford, have by an Instrument under their hands, bearing date the seventeenth day of March, in the year One thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine, certified to us, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, that it would be for the convenience of the said Parish of Little Ilford that the said Church of Saint Michael and All Angels, Little Ilford, situate within such parish, should be substituted for the old parish church (known as the Church of Saint Mary the Virgin) of the said parish.

Now, therefore, we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in exercise and execution of the power or authority in that behalf contained in the Act of the eighth and ninth years of Her late Majesty, Queen

Victoria, chapter seventy, and in the Act of the nineteenth and twentieth years of Her said late Majesty, chapter fifty-five and of all other powers or authorities in anywise enabling us in the same behalf, do by this Instrument under our Common Seal, with the consent (testified as hereinafter mentioned) of the said Henry, Bishop of Chelmsford, of the Right Honourable Hugh Richard Heathcote Cecil, commonly called Lord Hugh Cecil, Arthur Thomas Loyd, of Lockinge House, Wantage, in the County of Berks, Esquire, the Right Reverend Henry Herbert, Bishop of Carlisle, and the said Cecil Herbert Stuart Fifoot, being four of the said Hertford College Advowson Trustees, and of the said Hubert Arthur Stanley Pink, hereby declare that the said Church of Saint Michael and All Angels, situate within the said Parish of Little Ilford and duly consecrated as aforesaid, shall be and the same is hereby substituted for the said old parish church of the same parish, and that the said Church of Saint Michael and All Angels shall henceforth be the parish church of the said Parish of Little Ilford in lieu of the said old parish church of the same parish as fully in all respects as if the said Church of Saint Michael and All Angels so hereby substituted, had been originally the parish church of the same parish; And we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in further pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities aforesaid, and with such consents as aforesaid (testified as hereinafter mentioned), do hereby transfer all the endowments, emoluments, and rights of or belonging to the said old parish church of the said Parish of Little Ilford or of or belonging to the Rector or Incumbent thereof, to the said Church of Saint Michael and All Angels (now being by virtue of these presents the parish church of the said Parish of Little Ilford) and to the Rector or Incumbent thereof and his successors for ever.
