

for constituting a separate District for spiritual purposes to be taken partly out of the New Parish (sometime Particular District) of Saint James, Shirley, and partly out of the Parish of Millbrook, both in the County of Southampton and in the Diocese of Winchester:

"Whereas we are satisfied that the said New Parish of Saint James, Shirley, and the said Parish of Millbrook are Cures wherein or in parts whereof the provision for public worship and for pastoral superintendence is insufficient for the spiritual wants of the inhabitants thereof and it has been made to appear to us that it would promote the interests of religion that the particular portions of the said New Parish of Saint James, Shirley, and of the said Parish of Millbrook which are hereinafter mentioned and described should be constituted a separate District in the manner which is hereinafter set forth:

"And whereas there is not at present within the limits of the said proposed separate District any consecrated Church or Chapel in use for the purposes of Divine worship:

"And whereas we have agreed to make and pay out of the Common Fund created by the firstly herein mentioned Act a grant of £200 per annum to the Minister of the said proposed separate District so soon as a Minister shall have been duly licensed in accordance with the provisions of the secondly herein mentioned Act and to his successors:

"And whereas the said grant of the said yearly sum of £200 will, after the publication in the London Gazette of an Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme, be made and secured by an Instrument to be executed by us, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, under our Common Seal in accordance with the provisions of the Act of the 29th and 30th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter III:

"And whereas there has been contributed and paid to the credit of our account at the Bank of England a capital sum of £2,000 towards the cost of erecting a permanent Church within and for the said proposed separate District:

"And whereas the contributors of the said capital sum of £2,000 towards the cost of erecting such permanent Church have nominated to us the Bishop of Winchester for the time being as the person to whom they desire that the whole right of Patronage of the said proposed District and, when such District shall have become a New Parish, then of the said New Parish, and the nomination of the Minister or Incumbent thereof should be assigned:

"Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Reverend Cyril Forster, Bishop of Winchester (in testimony whereof he has signed and sealed this Scheme, we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, humbly recommend and propose that all those portions of the said New Parish of Saint James, Shirley, and of the said Parish of Millbrook, which are described in the Schedule hereunder written, all which portions together with the boundaries thereof are delineated and set forth on the map or plan hereunto annexed, shall, upon and from the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your

Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme as aforesaid, become and be constituted a separate District for spiritual purposes and that the same shall be named 'The District of Saint Peter, Maybush, Southampton.'

"And we further recommend and propose that the whole right of Patronage of the said District so recommended to be constituted and, when such District shall have become a New Parish as aforesaid, then of such New Parish and the nomination of the Minister or Incumbent thereof shall without any assurance in the law other than this Scheme and any duly gazetted Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying the same and upon and from the day of the date of the publication of such Order in the London Gazette as aforesaid, be assigned to and be absolutely vested in and shall and may from time to time be exercised by the said Cyril Forster, Bishop of Winchester, and his successors for ever.

"And we further recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from recommending and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid or any of them in accordance with the provisions of the said Acts or of any of them or of any other Act of Parliament.

"THE SCHEDULE to which the foregoing Scheme has reference.

"The District of Saint Peter, Maybush, Southampton, comprising:—

"All those contiguous portions of the New Parish (sometime Particular District) of Saint James, Shirley, and of the Parish of Millbrook, both in the County of Southampton and in the Diocese of Winchester, which, taken together, are bounded upon the north-west partly by the Parish of Nursling and partly by the New Parish of Rownhams, both in the said County and Diocese, and upon the remaining sides, that is to say, upon the east, upon the south and upon the south-west, by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Rownhams from the said New Parish of Saint James, Shirley, at a point in the centre of Aldermoor Bridge which carries Aldermoor Road across Tanners Brook and extending thence generally southward along the middle of Tanners Brook (thereby following for a short distance the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint James, Shirley, from the said Parish of Millbrook) for a distance of 1 mile and 60 chains or thereabouts to the centre of the bridge or culvert which carries Oakley Road across such brook and extending thence generally north-westward along the middle of Oakley Road for a distance of 35½ chains or thereabouts to its junction with Wimpson Road and Mansel Road and extending thence generally north-westward along the middle of Mansel Road for a distance of 70 chains or thereabouts to its junction with the road called Brown Hill upon the boundary which divides the said Parish of Millbrook from the said Parish of Nursling."

And whereas drafts of the said Scheme have, in accordance with the provisions of the secondly hereinbefore mentioned Act, been transmitted to the Patrons and to the Incumbents of the Cures out of which it is intended that the District recommended in such
