FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (BIRMINGHAM PIG MARKET) ORDER OF 1939.

SUBJECT.

Prescribes conditions for the holding of markets for the sale of swine at Montague Street Pig Market, Birmingham.

FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) SPECIAL ORDER No. 67 OF 1939.

Declares an Area of approximately 15 miles radius round an Infected Place at Caldecote, Herts, to be an Infected Area for the purpose of preventing the spread of foot-and-mouth disease to which Area the provisions of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1938 are applied. The Area subject to restrictions lies in the counties of Bedford, Cambridge, Essex, Hertford and Huntingdon.

FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) SPECIAL ORDER No. 1 OF 1940.

Declares an Area of approximately 15 miles radius round an Infected Place at East Hornon, Essex, to be an Infected Area for the purpose of preventing the spread of foot-and-mouth disease to which Area the provisions of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1938 are applied. The Area subject to restrictions lies in the county of Essex.

LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930.

Witham and Steeping Rivers Catchment Board.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made an Order under the Land Drainage Act, 1930, confirming a Scheme submitted to him by the Witham and Steeping Rivers Catchment Board, under Section 4 (1) (a) of the Act, consequent upon the variation of the statutory map of the Catchment Area, so far as relates to the extent of the main river, by the Minister on the seventeenth day of July, nineteen hundred and thirty-nine, for the transfer to the Catchment Board of all such rights, powers, duties, obligations and liabilities (including liabilities incurred in connection with works) over or in connection with the watercourse which by the said variation became part of the main river as were immediately before the commencement of the said Act vested in or to be discharged by any drainage authority, and of any property held by such authority for the purpose of, or in connection with, any functions so transferred.

A copy of the Order may be seen at all reasonable hours at the Office of the Clerk of the Catchment Board, 28, Wide Bargate, Boston, and also at the offices of the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries, 10, Whitehall Place, London, S.W.1.

By Part III of the Second Schedule to the said Act, it is provided that if any person aggrieved by an Order desires to question its validity on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Act, or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with, he may, within six weeks after the publication of this notice, make an application for the purpose to the High Court, and if any such application is duly made, the Court, if satisfied that the Order is not within the powers of the Act, or that the interests of the applicant have been substantially prejudiced by any requirements of the Act not having been complied with, may quash the Order either generally or in so far as it affects the applicant.
