the Minister of Transport may upon the application of the Corporation allow the powers conferred by the Order shall cease to be exerciseable.

And whereas by his consent dated 11th July, 1939, the Minister allowed an extension of time for the exercise of the powers until the 12th January, 1940.

And whereas the Corporation have made application to the Minister for a further extension of time for the exercise of the powers conferred by the Order.

Now, therefore, the Minister hereby allows an extension of time for the exercise of such powers until the 12th January, 1941.
