On Sunday arrived here an Express from Rome, who brought the Pope's Bull condemning the Arch Bishop of Cambray's Book; By this Bull 'tis declared, That the said Book contains Opinions that are Erroneous, Pernicious, and Scandalous; And all Roman Catholics are forbid to Print, Copy, Read, or Hear the same read; What will be done by many of the Clergy of the *Romish* Church, and some Universities, particularly that of *Salamanca*, who have publickly approved this Book, and whether they will by some other Bull be obliged to retract the same, is yet uncertain; 'Tis doubted whether this Bull will be Registered in the Parliament of *Paris*, there being some Expressions in it, in relation to the *Gallican* Church, that are not very well liked here. Don *Andreas Benito*, who came from *Brussels* with the Character of Envoy from the Elector of *Bavaria*, to notify the Death of the Electoral Prince of *Bavaria*, had his Audience of Leave yesterday, and intends to return home in a few days. Monsieur *Mabuet*, Envoy Extraordinary from the Duke of *Lorraine*, arrived here last week, and has had Audience of the King, the Dauphin, the Duke and Dutchess of *Burgundy*, the Dukes of *Anjou* and *Berry*, and the Duke and Dutchess of *Orleans*. An Order is Published here, to forbid the carrying of Gold and Silver out of this Kingdom to *America*. Our Letters from *Neuf-Chatel* say, the Affairs of that Principality continue in the same Posture; The Dutchess of *Nemours* arrived there the 13th Instant, and was received with great Demonstrations of Respect. They write from *Copenhagen*, that the Count of *Chamilly*, the *French* Ambassador, made his Publick Entry there on the 28th of the last Month.

Portsmouth, March 16.
