FOOD AND DRUGS ACT, 1938.

NOTICE is hereby given that by the South Shields (Food) Order, 1940, dated the 13th day of February, 1940, the Minister of Health has declared that on and after the 1st day of April, 1940—

(a) the provisions of section 14 of the Food and Drugs Act, 1938, shall be in force in the County Borough of South Shields; and

(b) the provisions of section 89 (Registration of ice-cream manufacturers and premises) and section 90 (Power to refuse registration of or remove from register ice-cream manufacturers and premises) of the South Shields Corporation Act, 1935, shall be repealed.

A copy of the above mentioned Order may be inspected at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, South Shields, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on week days (except Saturdays) and on Saturdays between 9 a.m. and noon.

STREET TRADING.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Council of the Metropolitan Borough of Stepney, at a meeting held on the 28th day of February, 1940, did make, pursuant to the provisions of Section 36 of the London County Council (General Powers) Act, 1927, a Bye-law relating to the trading in streets by Licensed Street Traders.

Now notice is hereby further given that the said Council intend, at the expiration of one month from the date of the first publication hereof, to apply to the Secretary of State for confirmation of the said Bye-law, and that a copy thereof is deposited at the Municipal Offices, Raine Street, Wapping Lane, E.I., and is open between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 5 p.m. on any week-day (other than Saturday) and between 9.30 a.m. and 12 noon on Saturday

to the inspection of any ratepayer of the Borough of any street trader, without fee or reward, and further that I, the undersigned, will upon the application of any such ratepayer or street trader furnish a copy of the said Bye-law or any part thereof upon payment of sixpence for every hundred words contained in such copy.

Any objections or representations which any person desires to make in relation to such Bye-law should be addressed to the Under-Secretary of State, Home Office, Whitehall, S.W.1.
