SUBJECT.

Declares an Area of approximately 15 miles radius round an Infected Place at Fornham All Saints, Suffolk, to be an Infected Area for the purpose of preventing the spread of foot-and-mouth disease, to which Area the provisions of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1938 are applied. The Area subject to restrictions lies in the counties of Cambridge, Essex, Norfolk, and East and West Suffolk.
