GOVERNMENT OF INDIA ACT, 1935

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him under Section 4 (3) of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, proposes to make an Order confirming a Scheme submitted to him by the River Nene Catchment Board, under Section 4 (1) (b) of the Act, making provision for the following matters:—

(a) The constitution of the Holland Elloe Internal Drainage District and of a Drainage Board therefor.

(b) The abrogation of the powers of the Commissioners of Sewers for the county of Lincoln, city of Lincoln and county of the said city and part of the county of Nottingham so far as such powers are exercisable within the said district.

(c) The transfer to the said district of certain lands within the area of the South Holland Embankment Trustees and the abrogation of the powers of the Embankment Trustees in respect of the said lands.

(d) The transfer to the South Holland Drainage Commissioners of certain lands within the area of the Commissioners of Sewers.

(e) Certain matters supplemental to the matters aforesaid.
