

" THE FIFTH SCHEDULE.

" The territory to be dissevered from the said New Parish of Langley and annexed to the said New Parish of Saint Paul, Blackheath, being:—

" All that portion of the said New Parish of Langley which is bounded upon the south-west by the said New Parish of Saint Paul, Blackheath, and upon the remaining sides, that is to say, upon the north-east and upon the north-west by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Paul, Blackheath, from the said New Parish of Langley at the junction of Causeway Green Road with Wolverhampton Road and extending thence north-westward along the middle of Wolverhampton Road for a distance of 11 chains or thereabouts to the centre of the bridge which carries the Stour-bridge Branch Line of the Great Western Railway across such road and extending thence south-westward along the middle of the said line of railway for a distance of 7 chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Langley from the said New Parish of Saint Paul, Blackheath.

" THE SIXTH SCHEDULE.

" The territory to be dissevered from the said Parish of Christ Church at the Quinton and to be annexed to the Parish of Halesowen in the said County of Worcester and in the Diocese of Worcester, being:—

" All that portion of the said Parish of Christ Church at the Quinton which is bounded upon all sides as follows, that is to say, upon the south and upon the west by the said Parish of Halesowen, upon the north and upon part of the east by the said New Parish of Saint Paul, Blackheath, and upon the remaining part of the east by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Paul, Blackheath, from the said Parish of Christ Church at the Quinton at the junction of Long Lane and Feldon Lane, and extending thence southward along the middle of Long Lane for a distance of 15 chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said Parish of Christ Church at the Quinton from the said Parish of Halesowen.

" THE SEVENTH SCHEDULE.

" The territory to be dissevered from the said District of Saint Hilda, Warley Woods, and to be annexed to the New Parish of Saint Mary, Smethwick, in the said County of Stafford and in the said Diocese of Birmingham, being:—

" All that portion of the said District of Saint Hilda, Warley Woods, which is bounded upon the east by the said New Parish of Saint Mary, Smethwick, and upon the remaining sides, that is to say, upon the north, upon the west, and upon the south, by an imaginary line commencing at the point where the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Mary, Smethwick, from the said District of Saint Hilda, Warley Woods, crosses the middle of Three Shires Oak Road near its junction with Thimblemill Road and Abbey Road, and extending thence westward to and along the middle of Abbey Road for a distance of 19 chains or thereabouts to its junction with Barclay Road, and extending thence southward along the middle of Barclay Road for a

distance of 37 chains or thereabouts to its junction with Lightwoods Hill, and extending thence eastward along the middle of Lightwoods Hill for a distance of 9 chains or thereabouts to its junction with Adkins Lane and extending thence eastward along the middle of Adkins Lane for a distance of 6½ chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said District of Saint Hilda, Warley Woods, from the said New Parish of Saint Mary, Smethwick.

" THE EIGHTH SCHEDULE.

" The territory to be dissevered from the said District of Saint Hilda, Warley Woods, and to be annexed to the said New Parish of Smethwick, being:—

" All that portion of the said District of Saint Hilda, Warley Woods, which is bounded upon the north-east by the said New Parish of Smethwick, upon the north-west and upon the south-west by the said New Parish of Saint Mark, Londonderry, and upon the remaining side, that is to say, upon the south-east by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Mark, Londonderry, from the said District of Saint Hilda, Warley Woods, at the junction of Thimblemill Road and Stanhope Road, and extending thence north-eastward along the middle of Stanhope Road for a distance of 7½ chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said District of Saint Hilda, Warley Woods, from the said New Parish of Smethwick."

And whereas drafts of the said Scheme have been duly published in accordance with the provisions of the said Measures, and Notices have been transmitted to the persons or bodies entitled under the said Measures to receive Notice requiring any objections to such draft Scheme to be stated or transmitted in writing to the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners within the time prescribed in the Statutory Rules applicable to proceedings under the said Measures:

And whereas the prescribed time has elapsed and no such objections have been so stated or transmitted to the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners:

And whereas public notice of the certification to His Majesty in Council of the said Scheme and the consent thereto in writing of the Bishop of Birmingham and of the Bishop of Worcester has been duly given in the manner and within the time prescribed in the Statutory Rules aforesaid:

And whereas the said Scheme has been approved by His Majesty in Council:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice of His said Council, is pleased hereby to affirm the said Scheme and to order and direct that the said Scheme and every part thereof shall be effectual in law immediately from and after the date when this Order shall have been duly published in the London Gazette pursuant to the said Measures.

And His Majesty, by and with the like advice, is pleased hereby to direct that this Order be forthwith registered by the Registrars of the said Dioceses of Birmingham and Worcester.
