

Broughton. Thence in a south-westerly direction along the main road through Kirby, Great Busby, past Low House, Faceby Grange and through Swainby to Shepherd Hill. Thence in a southerly direction to Nether Silton, along the road passing the Old Quarries and Solomon's Temple, and by way of Moor Lane to its junction with Lead Lane.

Southern Boundary.

Thence through Nether Silton in a general westerly direction to Northallerton, along West Lane, Leake Lane, Stell Bank, passing Leake House, proceeding along Cotcliffe Bank and over Cotcliffe Bridge to the road junction at Point 207 by Crosby Moor Farm. Thence in a north-westerly direction along the road passing Crosby Court, along Sandy Bank and through Northallerton by way of Crosby Road, Friarage Street, High Street North and North End to North Bridge over the L. & N.E.R.

Western Boundary.

Thence in a general northerly direction along the main road to Great Smeaton passing Sheepcote Close, Crawford Grange, the disused Tile Works, and through Little Smeaton and Great Smeaton to the road junction by the Inn at High Entercommon, the point of departure.

An Area of approximately 13 square miles in the bed of the sea off the Coast of the County of York, including Robin Hood's Bay.

Northern Boundary.

Commencing at a point at high water mark on the Coast about $\frac{3}{4}$ mile south-east of the Fog Signal south-east of Whitby, thence in a straight line due east to a point situated on Latitude $54^{\circ} 28'$ North and Longitude $0^{\circ} 28' 50''$ West.

Eastern Boundary.

Thence in a south-easterly direction in a straight line to a point situated on Latitude $54^{\circ} 25' 30''$ North and Longitude $0^{\circ} 25' 36''$ West, thence in a straight line due south to a point situated on Latitude $54^{\circ} 23' 45''$ North and Longitude $0^{\circ} 25' 36''$ West.

Southern Boundary.

Thence in a straight line due west to a point on the Coast at high water mark about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile south-east of Blea Wyke Point.

Western Boundary.

Thence along the Coast at high water mark in a general north-westerly direction passing Robin Hood's Bay to the point of departure about $\frac{3}{4}$ mile south-east of the Fog Signal south-east of Whitby.
