MINISTRY OF HEALTH.

PUBLIC HEALTH (IMPORTED FOOD) REGULATIONS, 1937.

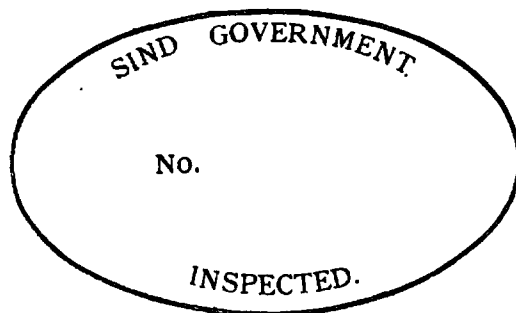
The Minister of Health gives notice, in
pursuance of the above-named Regulations,
that he hereby recognises the Official Certificate
of which particulars are given in the Schedule
hereto as showing (a) that the meat to which
it relates or the meat from which the meat
product to which it relates was prepared, was
derived from animals inspected ante and post
mortem and passed in accordance with criteria
satisfactory to the Minister; and (b) that all
necessary precautions for the prevention of
danger to public health were taken in the
dressing or preparing and packing of the meat
or meat product.

Where the Certificate is in the form of a
label, the recognition will apply only if the
label is securely affixed to the meat or to the
package containing the meat or meat product
and if the label has not in any other circum-
stances or on any other occasion been used as
an Official Certificate; and where the Certificate
is in the form of a stamp, the recognition will
apply only if the stamp is clearly impressed on
the meat or the container, as the case may be.

NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACTS, 1936 TO 1939.
