

And that, on account of urgency, the National Health Insurance Joint Committee, the Minister of Health, the Secretary of State for Scotland and the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, acting jointly, under section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made regulations entitled the National Health Insurance (Additional Benefits) Amendment Regulations, 1940, to come into operation immediately as provisional rules in their application to England and Wales and Northern Ireland, to continue in force until regulations have been made in accordance with the provisions of section 1 of that Act;

EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE).

ROAD TRAFFIC.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him under Regulation 70 and Regulation 98 of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, he has made the restriction of Traffic (Somerset and Dorset) (No. 2) Amendment Order, 1940. The Order terminates the operation of one-way traffic working in (a) the road at Milborne Port in the County of Somerset, (b) Walditch Road and Lower Walditch Lane in the County of Dorset.

Declares an Area of approximately 15 miles radius round an Infected Place at Braceby, Lincs., to be an Infected Area for the purpose of preventing the spread of foot-and-mouth disease, to which Area the provisions of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1938 are applied.
