## RULES PUBLICATION ACT, 1893.

## ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1930.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that he proposes after the expiry of at least forty days from this date in pursuance of the power conferred upon him by the Road Traffic Act, 1930, to make Regulations amending Regulations II, 36, 41, 53, 77 of the Motor Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations, 1937, and Regulations 34, 40, 63 of the Motor Vehicles (Construction and Use) (Track laying Vehicles) Provisional Regulations, 1937.

And notice is hereby further given that on account of urgency the said Minister has under Section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made the Motor Vehicles (Construction and Use) (Amendment) Provisional Regulations, 1940, to come into force forthwith as Provisional Regulations and to continue in force until Statutory Rules have been made in accordance with the provisions of Section 1 of that Act.
