COAST PROTECTION ACT, 1939.

BACTON, WALCOT, HAPPISBURGH—PROPOSED PROHIBITION OF REMOVAL, ETC., OF MATERIALS FROM THE SEASHORE.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Shipping intends to make an Order under the above Act to prohibit the excavation, removal or other disturbance of all materials (except minerals more than 50 ft. below the surface) on under or forming part of the seashore between the Watch House Gap, Bacton, and a point 1,700 feet south-east of Cart Gap, Happisburgh, in the Parishes of Happisburgh and Bacton in the County of Norfolk.

Copies of the draft Order may be inspected and obtained at the offices of the Clerk to the Smallburgh Rural District Council, Stalham, the Clerk to the Parish Council, Happisburgh, the Clerk to the Parish Council, Bacton, and the East Norfolk Rivers Catchment Board, 66, Bracondale, Norwich, and H.M. Coastguard Station at Happisburgh between the hours of 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. on any week-day except Saturday.
