(1) To extend to the 1st October, 1943, the period limited by Section 13 of the West Ham Corporation Act, 1931, as amended by Section 33 of the West Ham Corporation Act, 1937, for the compulsory purchase of the lands described in Part I of the First Schedule to the West Ham Corporation Act, 1931, which the Corporation by Section 5 of this Act are authorised to acquire but have not yet acquired;

(2) For the several purposes of the application or for purposes connected with, incidental to, or consequent on those purposes to make any such alteration or amendment of the said Local Acts, or of any other Local Act or of any Act confirming a Provisional Order made in pursuance of any of the Sanitary Acts or of the Public Health Act, 1875, and in force in the said Borough as may be necessary or desirable:

#### SPECIAL ENACTMENTS (EXTENSION OF TIME) ACT, 1940.

Whereas the Hartley Water Committee, the Mid-Kent Water Company and the Gravesend and Milton Waterworks Company have made

application to the Minister of Health for the issue of an Order under the Special Enactments (Extension of Time) Act, 1940, so as:—

(1) To extend to the 14th July, 1944, the period limited by section 75 of the North West Kent Joint Water Act, 1936, for the completion of the works which were authorised by that Act to be constructed and have not yet been constructed, that is to say:—

(a) Work No. 1.—A well and pumping station, as described in, and authorised by section 18 of the said Act to be constructed by the Hartley Water Committee.

(b) Work No. 2.—An aqueduct or line or lines of pipes as described in, and authorised by section 29 of the said Act to be constructed by the Mid-Kent Water Company; and,

(c) (i) Work No. 3.—A reservoir,

(ii) Work No. 4.—A waste water conduit,

as described in and authorised by section 30 of the said Act to be constructed by the Gravesend and Milton Waterworks Company.

(2) For the purposes of the Application or for purposes connected with, incidental to, or consequent on those purposes to make any such alteration or amendment of the said Local Act, or of any other Local Act or of any Act confirming a Provisional Order in force within the limits within which the said Companies are authorised to supply water as may be necessary or desirable:

And whereas it is proposed that an Order should be issued in compliance with the said Application:
