"The territory to be annexed to the Parish of Tatenhill in the said County and Diocese,

being:

"All that portion of the said New Parish

"big being of Saint Saviour, Branstone, which is bounded upon the north-east by the said New Parish of Saint Aidan, Shobnall, upon a part of the north by the portions of the said New Parish of Saint Saviour, Branstone, and of the said New Parish of Saint Aidan, Shobnall, which are described in the first and second schedules to this Scheme, upon the remaining part of the north by the said New Parish of the Holy Trinity, Anslow, upon the west and upon the south-west by the said Parish of Tatenhill, and upon the remaining side, that is to say, upon the south-east by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said Parish of Tatenhill from the said New Parish of Saint Saviour, Branstone, at a point in the middle of the footbridge over the Trent and Mersey Canal and extending thence northeastward along the middle of the said canal for a distance of I mile and 26 chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Saviour, Branstone, from the said New Parish of Saint Aidan, Shobnall.'

And whereas drafts of the said Scheme have been duly published in accordance with the provisions of the said Measures, and Notices have been transmitted to the persons or bodies entitled under the said Measures to receive Notice requiring any objections to such draft Scheme to be stated or transmitted in writing to the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners within the time prescribed in the Statutory Rules applicable to proceedings under the said Measures:

And whereas the prescribed time has elapsed and no such objections have been so stated or transmitted to the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners:

And whereas public notice of the certification to His Majesty in Council of the said Scheme and the consent thereto in writing of the Bishop of Lichfield has been duly given in the manner and within the time prescribed

in the Statutory Rules aforesaid:
And whereas the said Scheme has been

approved by His Majesty in Council:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice of His said Council, is pleased hereby to affirm the said Scheme and to order and direct that the said Scheme and every thereof shall be effectual immediately from and after the date when this Order shall have been duly published in the London Gazette pursuant to the said Measures.

And His Majesty, by and with the like advice, is pleased hereby to direct that this Order be forthwith registered by the Registrar

of the said Diocese of Lichfield.

WHEREAS the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England have, in pursuance of the Act of the 7th and 8th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 94, of the Act of the 13th and 14th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94, and of the Act of the 32nd and 33rd years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94, duly prepared and laid before His Majesty in Council, a Scheme or Representation, bearing date the 10th day of October, 1940, in the words and figures following, that is to say:

"We, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting under the provisions of the Act of the 7th and 8th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 94, the Act of the 13th and 14th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94, and the Act of the 32nd and 33rd years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94, have prepared and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council, the following Scheme or Representation for altering the boundaries of the New Parish of Wotton Saint Mary Without, in the County of Gloucester and in the Diocese of Gloucester:

"Whereas by the authority of an Order of His late Majesty King George the Fifth in Council bearing date the 9th day of April, 1932, and published in the London Gazette on the 12th day of the same month, a separate District was constituted for spiritual purposes and the same was named 'The District of Wotton Saint Mary Without ':

"Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Reverend Arthur Cayley, Bishop of Gloucester (in testimony whereof he has signed and sealed this Scheme or Representation), we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, humbly represent, recommend and propose that from and after the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme or Representation and without any assurance in the law other than such duly gazetted Order, the boundaries of the said New Parish of Wotton Saint Mary Without shall be altered so that all that portion of the Parish of Churchdown in the said County and Diocese which is described in the Schedule hereunder written and is delineated and set forth upon the map or plan hereunto annexed and is thereon coloured pink shall be dissevered from such Parish and shall be annexed to and shall in future form part of the said New Parish of Wotton Saint Mary Without.

"And we further represent, recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from representing, recommending and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid, or any of them, in accordance with the provisions of the hereinbefore mentioned Acts, or of any of them or of any other Act of Parliament.
