Cadiz, May 14. N. S.

THE *Pensance* and *Line* Men of War arrived here the 7th, in Company of two English Ships laden with Stores and Provisions for the Squadron commanded by Admiral *Aylmer*, who, according to our freshest Advices, was sailed from *Algiers* for *Calari* in *Sardinia*, where he intended to take in Water, and then proceed to *Tunis* and *Tripoli*. The *Sea-Horse* Man of War came in here two days ago. The *Pool* sailed from hence yesterday, to cruise against the Ships of *Sally*. The *Montague*, Capt. *Collier* Commander, arrived here last week from *England*, and sailed again this day for the *East-Indies*.

Madrid, May 22. The Scarcity of Provisions continues very great here; The Almirante of *Castile* is banished 30 miles from Court, and is forbid to return without a special Order from the King. His Catholick Majesty continues in very good Health; It's said, he will shortly go to *Aranguex*, or *Toledo*, for the benefit of the Air. They write from *Cadiz*, that the Commerce are lading their Ships designed for the *West-Indies*, and that they may be ready to sail in the beginning of the next Month.

Rome, May 16. The Marquis of *Virelli* is come hither with the Character of Ambassador Extraordinary from the Great Duke of *Tuscany*, to desire the Pope will give the Great Duke the Title of *Royal Highness*, as has been already done by the Emperor; Count *Martinitz*, the Imperial Ambassador, has visited the Marquis de *Virelli*, and paid him the same Honours as are practised to Ambassadors of Crowned Heads. The Prince of *Mosaco* is shortly expected here as Ambassador Extraordinary from *France*, and Signior *Erizzo* with the same Character from the Republick of *Venice*; Their Servants and Equipages being already arrived. The Congregation of the Inquisition is assembled, to consider of the Means to suppress some new Heresies that begin to spread in the Ecclesiastical State, and in the Kingdom of *Naples*. The Pope has sent Signior *Ferretti*, Commander of his Gallies, to *Nepesino* with a considerable Sum of Money to carry on the Works for repairing the Port of *Auzo*, in which very little Progress is hitherto made.

Warsaw, May 23. The King of *Poland's* Foot-Guards, and some other Regiments, are ordered to encamp near this Place. We have an Account, that the greatest part of the Provincial Diets are separated, having chosen their Deputies, who are shortly expected here in order to the holding of the General Diet, which is to meet on the 16th of the next Month. The Resident of *Muscovy*

had Audience of the King last week, and delivered to him a Letter from the Czar his Master, offering his good Offices for Accommodating the Differences between this Court and the Elector of *Brandenburgh*, in relation to the Affair of *Elbing*. We have received an Account from *Lemberg*, that the Commissioners appointed to take Possession of *Caminiec* being arrived there, that Place was delivered up to them by the Turkish Commander. The *Turks*, who inhabited there during the time this City was in the Sultan's Possession, are retired into the *Ottoman* Dominions; and divers of the Inhabitants of the Neighbouring Country are gone to settle at *Caminiec*.

Vienna, May 27. The Imperial Court is returned to *Laxembourg*, where great Preparations are made for Celebrating the Emperor's Birthday on the 9th of *June*. Count *Anthony* of *Dietrichstein*, who is appointed by the Emperor to make the Compliment of Condoleance to the Elector of *Bavaria* upon the Death of the Electoral Prince his Son, is on his departure for *Brussels*. Count *Zedenicki* will return in a short time to *Warsaw*, where he has resided some time with the Character of the Emperor's Envoy. The Count de *Wen*, who lately came hither as Envoy Extraordinary from the Duke of *Savoy* to notify the Birth of the Prince of *Piedmont*, has had Audience of the Emperor. The Barone of *Houchin*, General of the Artillery, died on *Saturday* last. The time of the Emperor's Journey to *Presbourg*, is not yet fixed. They write from *Hungary*, that the Line which is to serve for a Boundary between the Emperor's and the Sultan's Dominions, from the Shore of the *Danube* opposite to the Mouth of the *Theysse* to the *Sarve* near *Sweren*, is wholly finished, and the Imperial and Turkish Commissioners were settling the Limits of *Croatia*. They are gathering together a great quantity of Provisions at *Effeck* and *Buda*, for the Subsistence of the Troops that are to encamp in those Parts this Summer.

Francfort, May 31. Yesterday the Commander of our Garrison took a Review of the same, and disbanded about 300 Soldiers. The Elector Palatine's Officers are raising Soldiers in these Parts to recruit their Regiments. The Elector of *Mentz* is gone from *Aschaffembourg* to *Bamberg*, and the Landgrave of *Hesse-Cassel* is come to *Embs*.

Hamburg, June 5. The Duke of *Mecklenbourg Swerin* is shortly expected here, to renew the Conferences for adjusting the Pretensions which he and the Duke of *Strelitz* make to the Duchy of *Gustrow*. The Duke of *Holstein* went from this Place on the 2d Instant to *Staden*, where having reviewed
