

SPECIAL ENACTMENTS (EXTENSION OF TIME) ACT, 1940.

THE Minister of Transport has made the Southern Railway (Extension of Time) Order, 1940 (S.R. & O. 1940, No. 2135), extending by three years the time limited by Sections 8 and 31 of the Southern Railway Act, 1935, for the

completion of certain railways, and by Section 34 of the Southern Railway Act, 1937, for the acquisition of certain lands.
