The Civil Service Commissioners hereby give
notice that, with the approval of the Lords
Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, the
following amendments have been made to
Clause 4 of the General Regulations (dated 6th
April, 1923), respecting appointment to His
Majesty's Civil Establishments made under the
Order in Council of 22nd July, 1920, viz.:—

Third paragraph, line 3:—

After "Great War" add "1914-
1918)".

Add a fourth paragraph:—

"Provided further that in the case of
persons whose health has been impaired by
reason of service in His Majesty's Forces
during the War which commenced on the
3rd September, 1939, the Commissioners
may on the same conditions and in the
same manner issue Modified (War) Certifi-
cates and Special Recommendations which
shall have effect as if the provisions of
Articles 1, 2, 4 and 5 of the Order in
Council of the 22nd March, 1918, had been
extended to apply to such persons."

**SPECIAL ENACTMENTS (EXTENSION OF
TIME) ACT, 1940.**

Whereas the Mayor, Aldermen, and Burgesses
of the Borough of Southampton (hereinafter
called the Corporation) have made application
to the Minister of Health for the issue of an
Order under the Special Enactments (Ex-
tension of Time) Act, 1940, so as:—

(1) To extend to the 31st October, 1944,
the period limited by sub-section 1 of section
29, of the Southampton Corporation Act,
1931, for the completion of certain works as

described in section 25, of the said local Act
which the Corporation by this section were
authorised to construct and have not yet
completed, that is to say:—

(a) *Work No. 1.*—An intake from the
river Itchen and a pump-house in the
parish of Otterbourne in the rural district
of Hursley in the enclosure numbered 132
on the 1/2500 Ordnance Map of Hamp-
shire sheet No. L.13 (edition of 1909);

(b) *Work No. 4.*—Purification and other
ancillary works in the said parish of Otter-
bourne and in the enclosure numbered 123
on the 1/2500 Ordnance map of Hampshire
sheet No. L.13 (edition of 1909);

(c) *Work No. 8.*—A line or lines of pipes
in the said parish of Otterbourne and in the
said parish of Twyford commencing in the
road from Eastleigh to Winchester at a
point 80 yards east of the Southern Rail-
way Bridge at Allbrook and terminating
near Manor House Farm at Twyford;

(d) *Work No. 13.*—A line or lines of
pipes in the said parish of Otterbourne
commencing in the road from Eastleigh to
Winchester opposite Rookwood and
terminating in the said road at a point
1 chain north-west of the Southern Rail-
way Bridge at Allbrook.

(2) For the purposes of the Application or
for purposes connected with, incidental to, or
consequent on those purposes to make any
such alteration or amendment of the said local
Act, or of any other local Act or of any Act
confirming a Provisional Order in force within
the limits within which the Corporation is
authorised to supply water as may be neces-
sary or desirable:

And whereas it is proposed that an Order
should be issued in compliance with the said
Application:

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of
