SPECIAL ENACTMENTS (EXTENSION OF TIME) ACT, 1940.

THE London and North Eastern Railway Company are applying to the Minister of Transport for an Order under the Special Enactments (Extension of Time) Act 1940 extending by three years—

(1) the time limited by section 45 of the London and North Eastern Railway (London Transport) Act 1936 for the exercise of the powers conferred upon them for the completion of Railways Nos. 1 and 2 at Finsbury Park authorised by the London and North Eastern Railway Act 1924 (Section 5); and

(2) the time limited by section 22 of the London and North Eastern Railway Act 1938—

(a) for the compulsory purchase of the lands required for Widening (No. 1) in the parish of Whetstone in the rural district of Blaby in the county of Leicester, and Widening (No. 3) in the urban district of Hucknall in the county of Nottingham, authorised by the said Act of 1938 (Section 5); and

(b) for the compulsory purchase of the lands hereinafter referred to described in and authorised to be acquired by the said Act of 1938 (Section 17), viz.:—

In the County of Essex—

Lands in the borough of Ilford on the east side of the Company's Ilford to Woodford Railway south of Hainault Station;

In the County of Warwick—

Lands in the parishes of Wolfhampcote and Willoughby in the rural district of Rugby, and in the borough of Rugby;

In the County of Leicester—

Lands in the parish of Shawell in the rural district of Lutterworth;

In the County of Nottingham—

Lands in the parish of Ruddington in the rural district of Basford.
