Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas)

Subject.

Contracts the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area around Tarporley, Tattenhall, Chorley and Wardle, Cheshire, declared by Order No. 6115, to an area comprising the districts situate within approximately 15 miles of Aston, near Nantwich, Cheshire, as from 12th May, 1941.

Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas)

Subject.

I. Revokes Orders No. 6111 and 6112 as from 11th May, 1941, and contracts the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area around Tupsley, Shobdon and Canon Pyon, Hereford, to an area comprising the districts situate within approximately 5 miles of Canon Pyon.

II. Releases the contracted Infected Area from restrictions on 18th May, 1941.
