Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made an Order under the Land Drainage Act, 1930, confirming a Scheme submitted to him by the River Welland Catchment Board, under Section 4 (1) (b) of that Act, making provision for the following matters:—

1. The constitution of the Bourne and Thurlby Internal Drainage District and of a Drainage Board therefor;
2. The abolition of the Bourne South Fen and Thurlby Fen Drainage District and the Drainage Board thereof, and of the area under the jurisdiction of the Bourne South Fen Interior Drainage Commissioners, and the Commissioners thereof;
3. The abrogation of the powers of the Welland Drainage Board and the Glen Bank Trustees so far as they are exercisable within the area of the said Internal Drainage District;

4. Certain matters supplemental thereto; and that the Order will become final and have effect as an Act of Parliament unless within thirty-one days from the date of this Notice a Memorial is presented to the Minister by some person or body affected and having an interest sufficient for the presentation of a memorial, praying that the Order shall not become law without confirmation by Parliament.
