parts of the vessel as high as 1,000 feet. Flight Lieutenant Sydney-Smith has consistently displayed great courage and determination while Sergeant Shepherd's navigation and bomb aiming have been of a very high standard.

Distinguished Flying Medal.

804274 Sergeant George John Evans, Auxiliary Air Force, No. 604 Squadron.

This airman has been continuously employed on operational flying since September, 1939. He has displayed great skill in his duties and has assisted his pilot in the destruction of three enemy aircraft.

624846 Sergeant James GRAHAM, No. 7 Squadron.

In June, 1941, this airman was the rear gunner of an aircraft which was attacked by two enemy fighters about 20 miles west of His aircraft was attacked simul-Texel. taneously from the port and starboard quarters. During the combat, Sergeant Graham's reflector sight became unserviceable and two of his guns jammed. Despite continuous attacks, Sergeant Graham coolly repaired the damage to his reflector sight and cleared the gun stoppages after which he withheld his fire until one of the attacking aircraft was in close range. He then fired a long burst which caused it to break away and subsequently dive straight into the sea. Sergeant Graham displayed excellent technical and shooting ability under extremely difficult circumstances.

742771 Sergeant James Douglas Vernon Stewart STEPHENS, Royal Air Force Volunteer Re-serve, No. 83 Squadron.

One night in June, 1941, this airman was the pilot of an aircraft which carried out a successful attack on the marshalling yard at Soest. The vicinity of the target area was obscured by low cloud and visibility was poor but Sergeant Stephens descended to 1,000 feet and made a careful reconnaissance by the light of flares dropped from other aircraft. Finally locating his objective he released his bombs which were seen to burst on the permanent way. He then descended to 800 feet and machine gunned a train standing in the marshalling yard. Sergeant Stephens has at all times shown great keenness, initiative and courage.
