DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACTS,
1894 TO 1937.

Notice is hereby given in pursuance of Section 49 (3) of the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894, that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made the following Order:—

Order No. 6162.

(Dated 30th August, 1941.)

Applies Part III (Double Dipping of Sheep in a Double Dipping Area) of the Sheep Scab Order of 1938 to an area comprising parts of the counties of Westmorland and the North and West Ridings of Yorkshire and requires all sheep in the area to be double dipped during the period 1st December to 31st December, 1941.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made an Order under the Land Drainage Act, 1930, confirming the Scheme submitted to him by the River Great Ouse Catchment Board under Section 4 (1) (b) of the Act, making provision for the abolition of the Houghton and Wyton Drainage Commissioners and for the constitution of the Houghton and Wyton Internal Drainage District and of a Drainage Board therefor, and for certain matters supplemental thereto.
