SPECIAL ENACTMENTS (EXTENSION OF TIME) ACT, 1940.

Whereas the Urban District Council of Clacton (hereinafter called the Council) have made application to the Minister of Health for the issue of an Order under the Special Enactments (Extension of Time) Act, 1940:—

(1) To extend by three years the period limited by section 10 of the Clacton Urban District Council Act, 1938, for the compulsory purchase of the lands which the Council are authorised to acquire by section 5 of that Act but have not yet acquired;

(2) For the several purposes of the application or for purposes connected with, incidental to, or consequent on those purposes to make any such alteration or amendment of that Act, or of any other local Act or of any Act confirming a Provisional Order, in force in the said District, as may be necessary or desirable.

And whereas it is proposed that an Order should be issued in compliance with the said application;

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Health will consider any objections or representations made in writing before the 6th day of October, 1941, by any person or body interested in the subject matter of the said application and the proposed Order.
