DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACTS, 1894 TO 1937.

Notice is hereby given in pursuance of Section 49 (3) of the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894, that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made the following Orders:—

Order No. 6163.

(Dated 13th October, 1941.)

Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas)
Special Order No. 113 of 1941.

Subject.

Declares an area comprising the districts situate within approximately 15 miles of Penn,

Wolverhampton, to be an Infected Area for the purpose of preventing the spreading of foot-and-mouth disease, to which Area the provisions of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1938 are applied. The Area subject to restrictions lies in the counties of Salop, Stafford, Warwick and Worcester.

Order No. 6164.

(Dated 14th October, 1941.)

Animals (Landing from Eire, Northern Ireland and Isle of Man) (Amendment) Order of 1941 (No. 11).

Subject.

(I) Allows the importation at approved landing places in Great Britain on and after 20th October, 1941, of cattle, sheep, goats or swine brought from Eire, Northern Ireland or the Isle of Man. Such animals may not be moved from the landing place except under licence to a slaughterhouse nominated by the Ministry of Food for slaughter within ten days after their arrival thereat.

(II) Allows the importation at approved landing places in Great Britain on and after 27th October, 1941, of cattle, sheep, goats or swine brought from Eire, Northern Ireland or the Isle of Man for movement to farm premises under licence, where they shall be detained and isolated from all other animals for a period of ten days after their arrival thereat.
