GOVERNMENT OF BURMA ACT, 1935

(26 Geo. 5 & 1 Edw. 8, c. 3).

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Secretary of State for Burma, after the expiration of at least forty days from this date, in the exercise of his powers under Section 104 (1) of the Government of Burma Act, 1935, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, to make an amendment in the Burma Reserved Posts (Civil Medical) Rules, 1939 (S.R. & O. 738 of 1939).
