out in extremely adverse weather. In the last few months, Flight Sergeant Livingstone has achieved much success in his attacks on enemy shipping. He has succeeded in scoring hits on no less than 3 heavily escorted vessels. As captain of aircraft, he has shown a strong sense of responsibility, great courage and devotion to duty.

N.Z.403990 Flight Sergeant Anthony Ridley ROBSON, Royal New Zealand Air Force, No. 485 (N.Z.) Squadron.

Flight Sergeant Robson has completed 32 sorties over enemy occupied territory. From the start he has shown both courage and determination in his desire to engage the enemy. He has destroyed I and probably destroyed another hostile aircraft.

Aus.402500 Sergeant Adrian Philip Goldsmith, Royal Australian Air Force, No. 126 Squadron.

This pilot has destroyed at least 5 enemy aircraft. On one occasion he dived through a strong enemy fighter screen to destroy a bomber. When engaged by the fighters he shot one of them down.
