SPECIAL ENACTMENTS (EXTENSION OF TIME)
ACT, 1940.

Under the above Act the Minister of War
Transport has made the Winchester-Preston Trunk
Road (Oxfordshire) Compulsory Purchase Order (No.
8) 1939 (Extension of Time) Order 1942 extending
the time within which the powers of compulsory
purchase conferred upon him by the Winchester-
Preston Trunk Road (Oxfordshire) Compulsory

TIME) ACT, 1940.

WEST HAM CORPORATION ACT, 1937.
