In pursuance of Section 1 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, the Minister of Labour and National Service hereby gives notice that he proposes at the expiration of forty days from the publication of this notice to make Regulations under Section 15 of the Factories Act, 1937, amending the Schedule to the Operations at Unfenced Machinery Regulations, 1938. This Schedule specifies various industrial processes of a continuous nature in connection with which operations of lubrication or of mounting or shipping belts may be carried out near unfenced parts of transmission machinery in motion when the circumstances are such that the operation cannot, without serious interference with the carrying on of the process, be deferred until the machinery is stopped, and subject to certain other conditions.
