NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACTS, 1936 TO 1941.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the National Health Insurance Joint Committee, the Minister of Health and the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, acting jointly after the expiration of at least forty days from this date, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 134 of the National Health Insurance Act, 1936, and section 8 of the National Health Insurance and Contributory Pensions (Emergency Provisions) Act, 1939, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, to make regulations to be entitled the National Health Insurance (Home Guard) Regulations, 1942;

And that, on account of urgency, the National Health Insurance Joint Committee, the Minister of Health and the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, acting jointly under section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made regulations dated May 19, 1942, and entitled the National Health Insurance (Home Guard) Regulations, 1942, to come into operation forthwith as provisional rules and to continue in force until regulations have been made in accordance with the provisions of section 1 of that Act.

Copies of the provisional regulations so made, which constitute the draft of regulations to be made
