### SECTION 7.

#### Revocation of Certificates of Naturalization.

The Secretary of State has revoked the following Certificate:—

The Secretary of State has also directed that Kathé Charlotte Schramm, the wife, and Herbert Gordon Schramm, Ingrid Kathé Schramm and Wendy Schramm, the minor children of the said Herbert Paul Konrad Schramm, shall cease to be British subjects.
