Venice, Jan. 15. The Senate have resolved to make use of the present time of Peace, to repair and augment, as shall be found necessaryall their Frontier Places in Dalmaria and the Morea, and to provide them with good Magazines. Most of the Servants and Equipage of Count Berka, Ambassador from the Emperor to this Republick, are arrived here, and his Ex-ellency is expected in few days; 'Tis faid, he has all the necessary Powers and Instrudions for accommodating the Differences between the Emperor and this State about the Limits of their respective Dominions on the Borders of Dalmatia and Croatia. The Duke of Mantua has fent part of his Retinue to Mansua, however 'tis believed he will continue in this City till the Carnaval is over. Cardinal Cornarc, Bishop of Padua, is taking Informations concerning the Life and Conversation of Cardinal Barberigo his Predecessor in that Bishoprick, in order to his being Canonized. Letters from Rome of the 29th of the last Month fay, the Pope was quite freed of his Feaver, but continued still extream weak; He has not yet declared the two Cardinals he referved in Petto, nor fixed upon the Choice of Nuncio's to be fent to the Courts at Vienna, Paris, and Madrid, in the Room of the Nuncos now there, who being made Cardinals, are ordered to return hither, althô he is very much pressed to do both by Cardinal Spada, and the other Cardinals that have the liberty of coming I the King-

Warfaw, Jan. 3. fent an Express to the King of Foland with the Universalia or Circular Letters for calling together a General Diet, which, as foon as the King has figned them, will be fent to the feveral Palatinates, that they may chuse their Deputies, and the Diet be ready to sit immediately after the King's return hither, who is expected in a short time. They write from Cracow, that the Bishop of that Place died there some days ago; He will doubtless be much regreted by the King, to whom he was very ferviceable at the time of his Election, having Proclaimed and Crowned him King upon the Primate's refusing to do it. Lieurenant General Greben is appointed to be Governor of the City of Elbing, and has received Orders to march thither with his Regiment, in order to take Possession of that Place as soon as the Elector of Brandenburgh's Forces have evacuated it.

Copenhagen, Jan. 12. Vienna, Jan. 8. There has been laid before ! the Emperor, a Plan of the new Fortifications that are deligned to be made at Arat, which Place is looked upon to be very well fituated to detend the German Frontiers on that side, and to hinder the Incurtions of the Garriton of Temeficaer, and therefore Directions are fent to the Commanders of the Imperial Forces in those Parts, to take care that all possible Diligence be used to finish the said Fortifications, and because the Winter does interrupt this Work, they are particularly directed to get all the necessary Materials in a readiness to renew it as foun as the Weather will allow thereof. The greatest part of the Deputies of the States of Lower Austria are arrived here, who will open their Assembly in two or three days. Tis said, the States of Hungary are likewise to meet in a short time at Presbourg, to consider of the Subsidies demanded of them by the Emperor, and to provide Quarters and Subfiftence for the Imperial Forces. The Turkish Ambaiiador continues his Journey hither very flowly, by reason of his numerous Retinue, and the great number of Horses and Camels they bring with them. Great Preparations are making here for the Ambassador's Publick Entry and Audience. The Companies of Burghers are ordered to be in Arms, and to be new Cloathed, and the Court will appear on this occasion with great Splendor and Magnificence; The Ambailador is to stay at Persenderf till every thing is ready for his Reception.
