

Oliver directed his pilot's evasive tactics with great presence of mind and 6 attacks were frustrated. On the return flight another enemy fighter attempted to attack but Sergeant Oliver delivered a telling burst of fire from close range, causing the enemy aircraft to lose height rapidly with flames issuing from it. Throughout this airman displayed commendable skill and determination and contributed materially to the success of the operation.
