Rome, June 5. The Great Duke of Tuscany continues here, and has visited the several Churches tinues here, and has vinted the leveral Churches to obtain the Indulgences which are granted on account of the Jubilee. The Pope has made him divers noble Prefents, and has promifed him feveral Relicks, and particularly the Body of St. Stephen, his Highness being Great Master of the Knights of the Order of St. Stephen, instituted by one of his Ancestors. The Great Duke of Tulcant resolving to be here Incognito, and Duke of Tuscany resolving to be here Incognico, and not to receive or pay any Vants of Ceremony, the Pope invited him to the Palace, and being brought into a Chamber adjoyning to that where the Confistory is held, when the Confistory was over and the Pope was retired, all the Cardinals that were there came to the Great Duke, and made him their Compliments. The Queen Dowager of Poland, and the Princes Alexander and Conflantine her Sons, are still here. The Pope has wholly put off his Journey to Port Anzo. The Prince of Monaco, Ambassador from France, has had Audience of the Pope, to acquaint him, that the Most Christian King is very well pleased with
