The KING has been graciously pleased to approve the following awards in recognition of gallantry displayed in flying operations against the enemy:

Distinguished Service Order.

Squadron Leader John Watson Allan 7), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, Acting Allan (89617), Royal A No. 256 Squadron.

Distinguished Flying Cross.

Distinguished Flying Cross. Flying Officer Harold James DAVIDSON (Aus.411444), Royal Australian Air Force, No. 256 Squadron. As pilot and observer respectively, these officers have displayed exceptional skill in recent opera-tions over Sicily. One night in July, 1943, they destroyed 2 enemy aircraft while the following night they destroyed 1 more. Two nights later, during one sortie, they shot down 4 Junkers 88's and 1 Cant 1007. Again, on the following night, they destroyed. 2 more hostile aircraft and thus in 3 nights' operations obtained 10 victories. This achievement is an excellent tribute to their out-standing skill and fine fighting qualities.

Bar to Distinguished Flying Cross.

Bar to Distinguished Flying Cross. Squadron Leader Jack Albert HOLMES, D.F.C. (33413), Royal Air Force, No. 190 Squadron. In June, 1943, this officer piloted an aircraft detailed to search for a dinghy containing the crew of an aircraft. After a flight of some 400 miles over the water the dinghy was located. Although a heavy sea was running, making the task of alighting the aircraft extremely hazardous, Squadron Leader Holmes skilfully came down alongside the dinghy and its occupants were hauled safely aboard the aircraft. This officer displayed superb airmanship and great determination throughout. throughout.

throughout. Acting Squadron Leader Ernest Edward RODLEY, D.F.C. (61472), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 97 Squadron. Since being awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross, this officer has taken part in very many sorties and throughout has made every endeavour to press home his attacks with accuracy and vigour. On one occasion he took part in an attack on Friedrichshafen. In spite of heavy and concentrated anti-aircraft fire, Squadron Leader Rodley accomplished his task successfully. On the way to North Africa, en route from the target, an explosion occurred in the aircraft, causing much damage. Nevertheless, Squadron Leader Rodley accomplished the journey and safely landed his damaged aircraft. This officer has invariably dis-played great courage and resolution.

Flight Lieutenant Joseph Henri James SAUVACE, D.F.C. (43035), Royal Air Force, No. 97 Squadron

Squadron. This officer has taken part in a large number of operations during which many important and well defended targets have been attacked successfully. In June, 1943, Flight Lieutenant Sauvage partici-pated in an operation against Friedrichshafen. Whilst over the target area his aircraft was exten-sively damaged by fire from the ground defences but he flew on to North Africa as planned and made a safe landing at an airfield there. His work on this occasion was typical of the deter-mination he has invariably displayed. cting Flight Lieutenant Cyril GosLING, D.F.C.

Miniation he has invariably displayed. Acting Flight Lieutenant Cyril GOSLING, D.F.C. (Can/J.9359), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 229 Squadron. This officer has taken part in a very large number of sorties in the Middle East. In recent operations over Sicily he has fought with great skill and determination and, within a short period has shot down 5 enemy aircraft. Flight Lieutenant Gosling has led his flight and, at times, the squadron with great ability. He has destroyed 9 hostile aircraft. hostile aircraft.

Acting Squadron Leader Vincent Cronkite MCAULEY, D.F.C. (Can/J.4761), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 7 Squadron.

Distinguished Flying Medal.

Distinguished Flying Cross.

Distinguished Flying Cross. Acting Wing Commander James Alfred Avory READ (39799), Reserve of Air Force Officers, No. 108 Squadron. During a period of the recent air operations over Sicily, this officer has displayed great skill and determination. This was well evidenced one night in July, 1943, when he destroyed 2 enemy aircraft, and again the following night when he shot down 2 more. Wing Commander Read has completed a large number of sorties and has displayed inspiring leadership and zeal. He has destroyed 7 enemy aircraft. aircraft.

Squadron Leader Ernest Reginald MEADS (70459), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 252

Squadron. This officer has participated in many sorties and has set an example of keenness and skill which has won the confidence of all with whom he has

flown. Recently, as leader, he took part in 3 sorties and the successes obtained pay a high tribute to Squadron Leader Meads' thoroughness and ability. He has rendered excellent service. flown.

Acting Squadron Leader John Milne CHECKETTS (N.Z.403602), Royal New Zealand Air Force, No. 485 (N.Z.) Squadron. This officer has led the squadron and, on occa-sions the wing, with great skill. He has invariably displayed great keenness to engage the enemy and has destroyed 2 enemy aircraft and damaged several more. In addition he has destroyed 2 E. boats and successfully attacked military installaboats and successfully attacked military installations.

Acting Squadron Leader Alec INGLE, A.F.C. (83980), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 609

Squadron. This officer has completed many sorties. By his exceptional skill and leadership he has contributed in a large measure to the successes obtained by the squadron which, within recent weeks has damaged some 15 ships. Squadron Leader Ingle, who has destroyed 5 enemy aircraft has rendered fine service.

Flight Lieutenant Brian Desmond BARKER (129452), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 77 Squadron.

Distinguished Flying Medal.

- 1333556 Sergeant Ronald George GODDARD, Royal Air Force, No. 78 Squadron. In air operations this officer and airman have displayed courage and fortitude of the highest order.

- Flight Lieutenant Colin McTaggart SHANNON (Aus.415055), Royal Australian Air Force, No. 76 Squadron.

 Pilot Officer William Claude ELLIS (132386), Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, No. 76 Squadron. One night in July, 1943, these officers were pilot and wireless operator/air gunner respectively of an aircraft detailed to attack Essen. When nearing the target, one of the port propellers was shattered and the engine caught fire. In spite of this, Flight Lieutenant Shannon went on to make a successful bombing run. The wireless apparatus was unserviceable as the aerials had been destroyed bût Pilot Officer Ellis resourcefully erected an emergency aerial and thus was enabled to re-establish contact with base and obtain bearings which proved of material assistance to his pilot on the return flight. Both these officers displayed great skill and tenacity, setting an excellent example.

Acting Flight Lieutenant Oliver Brook ROBERTSON (Can/J.10302), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 97 Squadron.

Squadron. One night in July, 1943, this officer piloted an aircraft detailed to attack Hamburg. When about to commence his bombing run one engine caught fire, while one of the wings was set alight. Almost immediately the bomber was illuminated by the searchlights. In spite of this, Flight Lieutenant Robertson pressed home his attack and afterwards flew the damaged bomber to this country. This officer displayed great courage and resolution in the face of harassing circumstances.

ying Officer William Robert Weir ANDERSON (Can/J.13558), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 405 (R.C.A.F.) Squadron. Flying

(R.C.A.F.) Squadron. One night in July, 1943, this officer was mid-upper gunner of an aircraft which was attacked by an enemy fighter during an operational flight. Although he sustained 4 wounds in the left arm, Flying Officer Anderson continued to fire his guns during 7 subsequent attacks until the hostile aircraft was sent diving towards the ground with I engine in flames. Flying Officer Anderson displayed great courage and fortitude in most try-ing circumstances.

Flying Officer Frank Stanley Foyston (Can/J.8166), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 252 Squadron. This officer has taken part in several sorties during which he has attacked shipping and other enemy targets with success. By his fine fighting qualities, keenness and devotion to duty, Flying Officer Foyston has set a most praiseworthy example example.

Flying Officer Geoffrey TURNER (Can/J.7326), Royal Canadian Air Force, No. 75 (N.Z.) Squadron. This officer has taken part in numerous sorties and has proved himself to be a fearless and skilful pilot. On one occasion he was severely injured as the result of a crash landing but, on recovery some months later, resumed operational flying with undiminished zest. One night in July, 1943, Flying Officer Turner piloted an aircraft detailed to attack Hamburg. Whilst over the target area, the air-craft collided with an enemy fighter which struck and broke off some 4 feet of the starboard wing. Other damage was sustained, making the bomber difficult to control. Nevertheless, Flying Officer Turner flew back to base and effected a safe land-ing. He displayed outstanding skill and determina-tion throughout. tion throughout.

Flying Officer Geoffrey Gordon WHITE (N.Z.414367), Royal New Zealand Air Force, No. 126 Squadron. This officer has completed very many sorties and This officer has completed very many sorties and obtained many successes. During a flight in May, 1943, he attacked a large motor vessel off the coast of Pantellaria. In the face of heavy anti-aircraft fire, Flying Officer White pressed home a deter-mined attack, setting the vessel on fire. In other sorties, he has destroyed at least 2 enemy aircraft. During the recent air operations over Sicily, Flying Officer White has displayed skill and courage of a high order. high order.

1380158 Flight Sergeant George Colin HARRISON, Royal Air Force, No. 467 (R.A.A.F.) Squadron. One night in July, 1943, this airman piloted an aircraft detailed to attack Essen. Whilst making his bombing run the aircraft was hit by fire from the ground defences. One engine was put out of action, while a second one caught fire. Almost immediately the bomber was again hit, causing it to dive violently out of control. Con-siderable height was lost but Flight Sergeant Harrison, by a skilful effort, regained control and evaded the defences. Two engines were unservice-able but course was set for base. Soon after cross-ing the enemy coast all moveable equipment was jettisoned and height thus being maintained, Flight Sergeant Harrison succeeded in reaching an air-field in this country. This airman displayed superb skill, great courage and determination throughout and was mainly responsible for the safe return of the crippled bomber.

This airman has taken part in a large number of operations, including attacks on shipping and mine-laying missions. In June, 1943, in the Aegean sea, he attacked an enemy vessel and, a little later, in the same area, attacked another; I of the vessels was set on fire. In the latter action, Flight Sergeant Taylor's aircraft was exten-sively damaged by anti-aircraft fire but, in the face of great odds, he flew it to an airfield and made a successful crash-landing. Flight Sergeant Taylor is a courageous and skilful pilot whose achievements have been worthy of the highest praise. praise

- praise. 1332929 Sergeant Stanley William GOODMAN, Royal Air Force, No. 218 Squadron. 974437 Sergeant John PARKINSON, Royal Air Force, No. 218 Squadron. One night in July, 1943, these airmen were pilot and flight engineer respectively of an aircraft detailed to attack Essen. When nearing the target area, the aircraft was hit and sustained much damage. The port flaps were set on fire but, displaying great promptitude, Sergeant Parkinson succeeded in putting out the flames with an extinguisher. Although the aircraft became diffi-cult to control, Sergeant Goodman pressed home his attack with vigour and afterwards flew the damaged aircraft to base. These airmen displayed commendable courage and resolution. commendable courage and resolution.

commendable courage and resolution. 1339011 Sergeant John Alwyn PHILLIPS, Royal Air Force, No. 405 (R.C.A.F.) Squadron. Sergeant Phillips is a skilful pilot who has taken part in many attacks against important enemy targets. One night in July, 1943, he was the pilot of an aircraft detailed to attack Cologne. During the operation his aircraft was attacked by an enemy fighter and sustained damage, making it difficult to control. The bomb doors were shot away but Sergeant Phillips flew on to the target where the bombs were released manually. This airman displayed praiseworthy skill and deter-mination. mination.

650538 Sergeant Mairne Edwin PLAXTON, Royal Air

50538 Sergeant Mairne Edwin PLAXTON, Koyal Air Force, No. 178 Squadron. One night in June, 1943, this airman was the flight engineer of an aircraft which attacked the airfield at Comiso. During the action, the aircraft was hit by fire from the ground defences. Two of the crew were injured, while a fire broke out near the crew were injured. While a fire broke out near the entrance hatch. Displaying great promptitude, Sergeant Plaxton succeeded in quelling the flames and afterwards rendered efficient first-aid to his wounded comrades; he also succeeded in freeing the rear gunner who was trapped in his turret. By his initiative and promptitude this airman contributed materially to the safe return of the aircraft.

1056289 Sergeant John Frederick TROTTER, Royal Air Force, No. 61 Squadron. In July, 1943, this airman was the air bomber of an aircraft detailed to attack an industrial plant at Bologna in Northern Italy. He displayed great skill and efficiency throughout the operation and proved himself to be a most valuable member of aircraft correct of aircraft crew.
